BULOVA ELECTS TWO DIRECTORS

ELECTED DIRECTORS—David H. Anderson, 56, an executive vice president of Bulova Watch Company, Inc., and R. Mark Bourquin, 52, president of Bulova Watch Company Limited (Toronto), a subsidiary, have been elected to the board of directors of Bulova Watch Company, Inc. Harry B. Henshel, chairman, announced today (May 6, 1974), in New York. Both executives joined Bulova in 1942, and both in recent years have

played major roles in the company's expansion abroad. Mr. Anderson, a resident of Providence, R. I., where he heads Bulova's Providence Division, continues as executive vice president, and Mr. Bourquin, a Canadian and a resident of Toronto, Canada, continues as president of the Bulova Watch Company Limited (Toronto), the Bulova subsidiary in Canada.

Anderson and Bourquin Have Had Major Roles in Bulova's Expansion Abroad

New York, May 6, 1974—David H. Anderson, an executive vice president of Bulova Watch Company, Inc., and R. Mark Bourquin, president of Bulova Watch Company Limited (Toronto), a wholly owned subsidiary, have been elected to the board of directors of Bulova Watch Company, Inc., Harry B. Henshel, chairman, has announced here.

Both executives joined Bulova in 1942, and both in recent years have played major roles in the company's expansion abroad, Mr. Henshel noted. Since 1959, when Mr. Henshel became chief executive officer, Bulova has

built a multinational production base, and entered more than 100 overseas markets.

Mr. Anderson, 56, has served as an executive vice president since 1966, and has been responsible for bringing new plants into operation in the U. S., Virgin Islands, Taiwan and West Germany. In addition, he directs the company's Providence Division, with five plants in the Rhode Island and (Sag Harbor) Long Island areas, that develops and produces watch cases for all of the company's watch brands. In the world watch industry, Mr. Anderson has long had a unique direct management role, Mr. Henshel observed, in that he is and has been responsible for the manufacture of watch movements and of watch cases, both complex assemblies of high-precision parts.

Mr. Anderson is also responsible for the William L. Langer Jewel Bearing Plant, in Rolla, N. D., the nation's sole producer of jewel bearings, which is operated by Bulova for the U. S. Government's General Services Administration.

He began his career with Bulova as an industrial engineer, was promoted to director of standards in 1945, to production manager, in Providence, in 1949, and to factory manager in Providence in 1954. He was named a vice president in 1957.

Mr. Anderson, a resident of Providence, R. I., continues as executive vice president.

Mr. Bourquin, 52, a Canadian citizen, first joined Bulova's subsidiary in Canada, Bulova Watch Company Limited (Toronto), as a watchmaker, after working as a watch technician in retail jewelry stores. In 1943, he joined the Royal Canadian Navy, and served aboard a Corvette on convoy duty in the North Atlantic. He rejoined the company in 1946, as a watchmaker, and in 1950 was promoted to Chief Watchmaker. The same year he was named manager of the subsidiary's watch material sales division, and in that capacity travelled continually throughout Canada, calling on jewelers.

In 1954, Mr. Bourquin was appointed Bulova sales representative for the Canadian Maritime Provinces and Newfoundland. In 1956 he was promoted to international sales manager in charge of exports to British Commonwealth markets. During this period he also served on the Board of Examiners of the Watchmakers Division of Canadian Jewellers Institute.

In 1960, Mr. Bourquin was named a vice president of Bulova International, a new marketing subsidiary. In 1961, he was assigned responsibility for developing new Far East markets. In that post, Mr. Bourquin headquartered in Hong Kong and developed the first Bulova retail networks in Singapore, Malaysia, Japan, the Philippines, Australia, New Zealand, Taiwan, Okinawa, Korea, Indonesia and Thailand. In 1967, he was named president, chief executive officer and a director of Bulova Watch Company Limited (Toronto), and returned to Canada. As President of the Bulova subsidiary, Mr. Bourquin has more than quadrupled Bulova's watch sales in Canada.
